

DOSBOX

DosBox is a DOS (Disk Operating System) emulator for running DOS programs from a Windows OS like XP or Vista. It was designed to run DOS based games but can be used to run most DOS programs. You will need to read the instruction to get access to your DOS program.

DOSBOX can be downloaded from <http://www.dosbox.com/download.php?main=1>

Installation:

DOSBOX - to install DOSBOX, download the file from the web and double click on the installation file which may be 'DOSBox0.72-win32-installer.exe' and accept all the defaults.

Using DOSBOX to run your DOS applications:

When you run DOSBOX you will see the introduction screen, from here you can type the necessary commands to 'mount' the drive where your TurboC is stored and other commands that will help you to use DOSBOX - read this first screen carefully.

If you want to display it in full screen mode press Alt+Enter.

To leave / Exit DOSBOX type 'exit' at the prompt and press 'Enter'.

Mounting a Drive:

If you have installed the TurboC to a folder on your C drive called TurboC3, then to access this through DOSBOX you must 'mount' the drive - in other words tell DOSBOX what you want to call your 'drive' and where it really is.

The mount command has two parameters, the drive letter you wish to assign to the location you want to access and the location you want to access.

```
mount H C:\TUBROC3
```

The above command would create a virtual drive called 'H' and through it give access to the TurboC3 folder on the 'C' drive. You can now change to your H drive by typing H: and pressing Enter and access the tutorial by typing 'start' at the prompt.
